

Toyosu Gururi Park "Toyosu Gururi Dog Run" Terms of Use

Toyosu Gururi Dog Run is a complete membership system.

If you want to use it, please complete the pre-registration.

Members who have registered for use must wear the registration card issued by the park management office and carry it with them where the owner can see it.

Unregistered dogs are not allowed.

Please register the necessary information from the Toyosu Gururi Park website.

This is a place where dogs and their owners can get along and have fun while learning good manners. In order to use the dog run with peace of mind, please observe the following terms of use and use the dog run.

[Operating hours] 24 hours a day, all year round

(Closed during year-end and New Year holidays and for administrative reasons.)

[Area] Small dog area: less than 10 kg Free area: all dog breeds

[Rules for use]  **Please be sure to read.**

- When using the dog run, users who are younger than junior high school age must be accompanied by a guardian.
- If you are traveling with children, please do not let go of them.
- Do not let go of the leash in front of the dog run entrance and inside the double doors when entering.
Be sure to enter the dog run and let the dog get used to it before letting go of the leash."
Also, when leaving, please attach a leash in front of the double door before leaving.
- Dogs that are unfamiliar with the dog run or that are not properly trained, such as not listening to the owner's commands, please do not remove the leash in the dog run.
- Owners should keep an eye on their dogs in the dog run.
- The dog run is a playground for dogs. Running around is an act of provoking the dog, so please do not touch or jump on a dog, as it is also very dangerous.
- If your dog chase a frightened dog, keep barking, or mount another dog, you should immediately stop the dog and put it on a leash to calm it down."
- Do not leave your dog or child unattended when going out temporarily to go to the bathroom.

- Dog toys should be limited to items that consider safety and do not pose a risk of troubles, especially ingestion-related issues. If you plan to use play equipment, please make sure to confirm with other users that it is safe to use.
- Dangerous play by users (catch ball, badminton, frisbee, etc.) is prohibited.
Also, as a general rule, bringing in leisure sheets, parasols, etc. is prohibited.
- The number of dogs allowed to enter is limited to the ones that the owner can control.
- Do not dispose of trash, dog feces, or other waste in the park's restrooms or leave them on nearby roads.

[Not allowed to enter]

- Dogs that have not been registered for use.
- Animals and pets other than dogs.
- Those who do not have a dog.
- Middle school students and younger users without parental supervision.
- Children under 3 years old (even with parental supervision) are not allowed to enter.
- Female dogs in heat (Male dogs can cause emotional instability.)
- Dogs that cause trouble such as biting on the day.
- Dogs that give fear to other users, such as dogs bred for fighting dogs and hunting dogs.

[Prohibitions inside the venue]

- Eating, drinking and smoking in the owner's premises.
- Bringing baby strollers and carts (including carts for dogs) is not allowed.
- Feeding dogs in the open space. (Please be careful when giving drinking water to other dogs.)
- Bringing in exercise equipment for your dog (Sports equipment, etc.) Grooming of dogs (brushing, etc.)
- Commercial use, sales activities, missionary activities, solicitation activities, etc.
- Unauthorized filming or interviewing for television or magazines, or filming that violates personal portrait rights.

[Other precautions and prohibitions regarding use]

- "Users" here are those who have registered as users and their companions, but the registration card cannot be transferred or rented. (Lending among family members is prohibited.) If you lose it, please report it to the management office and we will take care of it.

- When leaving the site, please check that there is no excrement litter, that the dog's toys have not been left behind, or that the owner has left something behind.
 - If there is any damage or breakage to the facilities in the venue, please contact the management office as soon as possible.
 - Please take responsibility for your dog's feces, pee, garbage, etc.
 - Please note that the facility may be closed if the administrator deems it dangerous due to heavy rain, strong winds, or disasters.
 - When using the facility, please communicate with other users and strive to improve manners. Follow the instructions given by the park management.
 - In case of accidents, please respond in accordance with the "Tokyo Metropolitan Animal Welfare and Management Ordinance." In the event of a dog biting a person or similar incidents, please provide appropriate first aid and take necessary steps to prevent recurrence, and report the incident.

- ◇ Personal information provided in the registration application form will only be used for the management and registration of membership cards, and will not be used for any other purposes.
 - ◇ Users who engage in behavior that violates the terms of use or causes inconvenience, and fail to comply with the guidance of park administrators, may have their membership registration revoked at the discretion of the park administrators. In addition, if false information is discovered during registration, the registration will also be canceled. Please promptly notify the park management center of any changes to your registration details.
 - ◇ This agreement will be effective from August 1, Reiwa 5 (2023). (The agreement may be subject to changes as needed.)

※Please use the facilities at your own risk while respecting the rules and respecting the rules. All troubles that occur in the dog run should be resolved between the parties regardless of whether they are dogs or people. The park management office is not responsible for any problems that occur on the premises.
